The aim is to pass the yellow ball from one side of the Twidget to the other. The yellow ball makes a 'popping' sound as it passes through the middle.

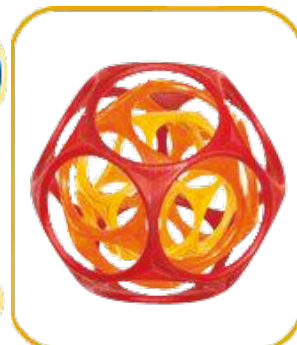

Pinch Grip

The Pinch Grip is similar to the Crossover Grip. It helps prevent the thumb and index finger crossing over, but unlike the crossover, it does not have the 'wings' over the top of the grip (see photo above to compare grips). This grip might be particularly useful for those who find the enclosed nature of the crossover grip design uncomfortable for writing. Like all the pencil grips, the Pinch grip is suitable for both left and right handed individuals. #683

**Bumpy Grip**

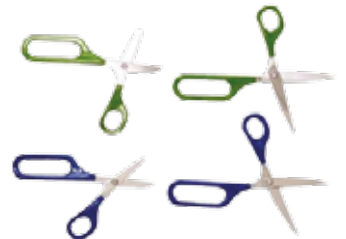

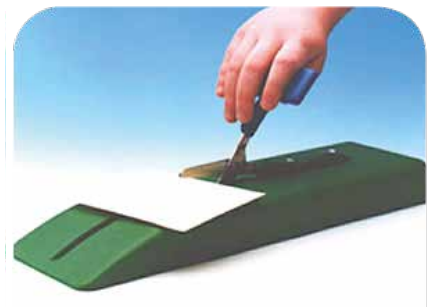

Oral Motor Tools

Oral motor tools can be useful for individuals who have a sensory need to chew (perhaps chew, hands, clothing, or other inedible objects). They can also be useful for those who are learning to chew or feed, to increase awareness or desensitising around the mouth and/or face, and developing speech skills.

The oral motor products in this catalogue are not toys. The clasp and cords on the necklaces are not intended for chewing. Contains small parts that may pose a choking hazard. Not recommended for children under 5 years.

The chewable tools in the catalogue vary in their strength or toughness. The softer chews are better for those who suck or chew lightly on objects, while the tougher (and harder) chews are designed for those who prefer to bite down on objects.

Although we have done our best to source sturdy chewable tools, it is important to note that no chew tool is indestructible. Wear and tear may be expected given the nature of the intended use. How long a chewable tool will last will depend on how a chew is used, how often, and the intensity of its use by an individual. Other variables, such as jaw strength, stress/anxiety levels may also influence the longevity of a chewable tool. For some people, a chew tool will last a long time. For others with heavy/aggressive oral needs, they may go through it very quickly. It is important that oral motor tools are replaced when chews show signs of wear. Parental/caregiver supervision is important at all times.



Right Bite

The Right Bite can be useful for individuals with feeding issues. Sometimes the ability to visually judge food and take an appropriately sized bite can be difficult.

Krypto-Bite Tube

Made in the USA, ARK's Krypto-Bite Tube Necklace provides a safe, wearable, and discreet solution for kids and adults who need to chew. It's gem/hexagon shape is very similar to the popular original Krypto-Bite™, except that it is slightly smaller and hangs horizontally instead. Use this oral motor tool to help calm, soothe, and self-regulate during times of stress, or to better focus during homework and other activities.

This pendant is medical grade, FDA compliant, and contains NO lead, phthalates, PVC, BPA, or latex. Measures approximately 5.5cm in length and 1.2cm diameter. #814

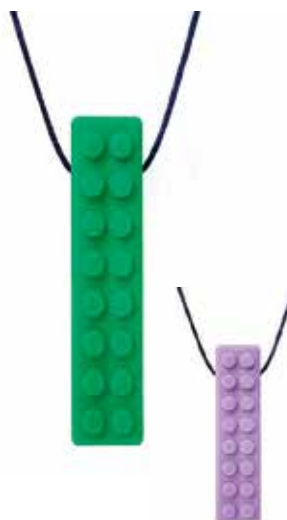


The Right Bite allows the therapist or caregiver to present a prescribed, manageable amount of food to the individual. Simply slide a cracker, cucumber slice, or the like into the opening until it protrudes from the semi-circle opening. Then offer the Right Bite to the individual and instruct him/her to "take a bite."

Since only a portion of the food is presented at a time, the Right Bite encourages appropriate bite sizes, which helps prevent mouth stuffing, and paces the rate of eating to allow for adequate chewing time. The Right Bite also helps eliminate the risk of the therapist or caregiver being bitten during feeding therapy. Made in the USA, medical grade, FDA compliant. No lead, phthalates, PVC, BPA, or latex. 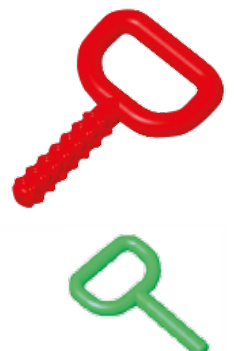

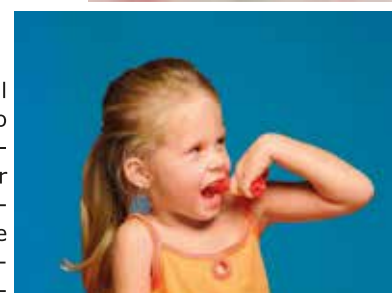
